Is My Water Fluoridated?

All public water systems have a unique identification number (PWS ID #). If you know the name of your water system or its PWS ID# you will be able to determine what the fluoride level is in your water. The Fluoride Data Table provides the County name, name and ID # of each community water system, population served and its fluoridation status. Below are definitions for terms used in the column entitled "Fluoridation STATUS":

Adjusted: The natural fluoride level is adjusted to the optimum level of 1.0 ppm (parts per million or mg/l).

Please note: the "Natural F- level" column lists the natural fluoride level **before** it is adjusted to 1.0 ppm.

Deficient: The water system has less than 0.8 ppm fluoride.

Natural: This means that the fluoride level is naturally at optimum (0.8ppm) or higher levels.

Adequate: This means the water system purchases fluoridated water from another public water system.

Some water systems purchase water. The "Purchase ID" column lists the PWS ID# of the system from which water is purchased so that the customer can determine the source system.

Please note: Some water systems have fluoride levels tested at commercial labs that report levels of fluoride that are less than 0.5 parts per million as "< 0.5 ppm". This is not specific enough for purposes of prescribing fluoride supplements. Health professionals should contact their local water plant in order to obtain more specific information on low fluoride levels.
